WHAT DOES THE HUTT RD FACILITY COST CROQUET SA?

It has often been said that having a central headquarters facility such as Hutt Rd is a burden on Croquet SA members.

One key advantage is having the Croquet SA office integrated rather than at a separate site. It is difficult to accurately separate the two costs, but the summary extract from the calculations below does that. The process looks at all Croquet SA incomes and expenditures and attributes those relevant to having the facility.

The calculations in the chart do NOT include party hires which involve use of the clubrooms and the lawns as details were not readily available.

Overall, the study has demonstrated that the users of the Hutt Rd facility are more than paying for the maintenance of the facility and in fact providing a small return to Croquet SA administration.

For individual and doubles events players are also requested to complete an on-line entry and are encouraged to submit entry fees direct to Croquet SA via bank transfer.
