# EDWARD (NED) WILSON FIRST AUSTRALIAN U21 GOLF CROQUET CHAMPION 2015 PLAYER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD RECIPIENT

In January 2016 the Inaugural Under 21 Australian Golf Croquet Championship was held in NSW. Edward Wilson, the only SA competitor, succeeded in winning the event. Congratulations Ned, what a great achievement to become the first Australian U21 Golf Croquet Champion and what a start to the year!

This fantastic effort was preceded by the perfect way to end 2015 with Ned being awarded the Croquet SA 2015 Player Achievement Award at Presentation Day. Well done!

Edward commenced playing Golf Croquet in January 2012 at age 13. The Association Croquet World Championship was held here in May that year and he spent time watching play at Millswood (where he met the Fletcher brothers) and Hutt Road for the finals. He came to notice when he won the ACA Men's Plate for golf croquet in 2014 defeating Australian higher ranked players. Following this he was selected to play in the World's Under 21 event in Christchurch January 2015.

During 2015 he has pursued his interest in AC but also continued training with the GC State squad as his game continued to improve. His mentor Greg Fletcher (current Australian champion) has generously encouraged, coached, trained and practiced with

Edward in the art and skills of playing AC. Triple peels and now sextuple peels are favourite practice territory and his handicap has rapidly come down. Ned has played in several invitation events. In August Ned completed his first triple peel in a competition at Hutt Road. He now has a collection of TPs, TPOs and OTPs to

his name.

His placement as runner up to Dwayne McCormick (current RU in the Australian Championship) in the Croquet SA President's Invitation has been his best result against top players. He is now aged 17 and just loves croquet. Congratulations again Ned on your fantastic achievements, SA is very proud of you!
