SOUTH AUSTRALIAN PLAYERS IN WORLD TOURNAMENT

Two South Australian croquet players have been awarded places to compete in the World Croquet Federation's World Golf Croquet Championships to be held in Egypt in October and November 2014.

David Wise (Norwood Croquet Club) will compete in the 2nd Over 50's Golf Croquet World Championship in Cairo in October 2014. David has been a member of both Association Croquet and Golf Croquet State teams for South Australia and his best placing has been second and third in the Golf Croquet Australian Open. He has also represented Australia at both the 2012 Association Croquet World Championship and 2013 Golf Croquet World Championship.



Bernie Pfitzner (Victor Harbor Croquet Club) will compete in the 5th Women's Golf Croquet World Championship in Cairo in November 2014. Bernie has competed in a number of national events including the Australian Golf Croquet Women's Championships in 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2012, the Australian Golf Croquet WCF Interstate Shield from 2009 to 2014 and captained the South Australian Golf Croquet Interstate Team in 2012. Bernie has also competed on an international level in the World Croquet Federation Women's Golf Croquet World Championships held in New Zealand in 2011 and the World Croquet Federation Golf Croquet World Championships in Cairo, Egypt in 2013.



President of Croquet SA, Ms Maree Skinner said, "The State Association is delighted to see two of its talented golf croquet players competing in these world-class championships and we wish them every success against what will be a very strong international player line-up in Cairo."



PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT

State wide funding for Hammer Time program has been successful. What an amazing opportunity to grow clubs, especially after all the fantastic exposure at the Royal Croquet Club, as well as building on the experience gained during the Hammer Time Pilot.

Now it's off to the professionals - the marketing/communication people to help us optimise the experience gained and to develop croquet into a thriving and relevant sport in the 21st century.

Other sports have had to reinvent themselves: cricket did it with the Big Bash, bowls did it with Night Owls, golf is concerned because its usual cohort are now turning into to MAMILs! Touch footy is booming etc

The characteristics of a successful club will underpin all our activities:

Things like a warm friendly club atmosphere with regular social functions. Clubs that do this well include Millicent in the SE with their great BBQs, or 'Wine Down' Friday evenings at Millswood, Norwood have a successful monthly BBQs which also helps with fund raising- I'm sure there are lots of other events happening around the state.

These gatherings are really important to prevent the 'them and us' frame of mind that can arise between the 2 codes – so be inclusive, find a time where most can attend, buy a few snags, crack open a beer/bottle and enjoy. Following on from building a friendly atmosphere is being ready to make the most of curious passers by - I heard that Brighton and West lakes are good at this. They have mallets close by, so if someone peers over the fence and starts asking, the individual will have a mallet in their hands and are hitting balls before they know it. Then you find out when they are free, offer them 2-3 free lessons and who knows where it will end

Several successful clubs play more than one code like North Adelaide, Naracoorte, Kadina, Port Lincoln, Murray Bridge etc etc. Playing more than one code broadens the number of potential players. As I've discussed over the last few months, there are many motivating factors for individuals when joining a sports club from serious competition, to a hit and a giggle or quality family fun and all can be valued members. Is there room/need for change at your club? Don't worry about the naysayers – they will always be there. Build on the successes, analyse and modify the weaknesses and help your club grow.
