#### AUSTRALIAN GOLF CROQUET OPEN DOUBLES AND SINGLES 2016 **CAIRNLEA, VIC**

South Australia was strongly represented at the Australian Open Doubles and Singles Event held in Victoria from 7-15 May, with 14 of the 34 players in the Doubles and 12 of the 25 in the Singles event. SA players returned home with six of the eight available trophies.

#### **Open Doubles**

The Doubles event was played with a qualifying single round robin, two SA players and Their partners made it into the top six pairs playing in a **knock out** finals series; Greg Fletcher (Hyde Park) & Fleur Brockway (WA) were defeated in the quarter finals, Edward Wilson (Millswood) & Malcolm Fletcher (Vic) were defeated in the semi-finals. The remaining pairs competed for the Plate with an outstanding result for SA. First place and congratulations to Mick Reidy and Stewart Kingsborough from

(Millswood) Second place to David Wise (Norwood) & Chris Grant (Vic). Equal Third place to Shirlene

& Ron McBride (Victor Harbor) and Barry Haydon (Hyde Park) & Graham Whiteway (Brighton).

#### **Open Singles**

The Singles event was played in two blocks, the top eight from each block qualified for the Knockout finals series.

Graham Whiteway and Barry Haydon qualified from Block A and Greg Fletcher, David Wise and Barry Jennings (Meningie) from Block B

#### Final Knockout Series Results - round of 16

- Greg Fletcher and Barry Haydon won and continued on the next round. David Wise won the Y playoff (9<sup>th</sup> overall). Barry Jennings won the W playoff (13<sup>th</sup> overall)

Final—Greg Fletcher became the Australian GC Singles Champion after defeating Peter Freer (NSW) in a hard played five games. 4-7, 7-4, 4-7, 7-4, 7-6. Greg is now currently both the Association and Golf National Open Champion. A fantastic achievement. Congratulations and well done Greg.

SA had six of the eight players contested the Plate. Plate Results Stage One was a single block round robin with the top four players to the semi-final. Semi-finalists: Anna Miller (Vic), Shirlene McBride, Ron McBride and Graeme Thomas. **Final**—Ron McBride went on to win the plate in a best of three games final. 7-4, 7–6

The Championships were played on Saturday 30 April in great spirit with the team to beat, Canberra, suffering a couple of defeats allowing the Cougars from Queensland to snatch the title. A doubles competition was held on the next day, the Canberra teams showing their class with an all Canberra final. After a very entertaining and close see-saw game, Bryan Johnson and Gilon Smith beat Glen Whitehead and Hilary White 14 points

to 11 – it was a great game to watch for the neutral observer.
