CRYSTAL BROOK COMMUNITY CROQUET CHALLENGE 2018

Social croquet was held on four Thursday evenings during March for any one who wanted to try a new sport. On most evenings there were at least 16 players, with up to 24 on one occasion. Adults and children all joined in, playing three games of Aussie Croquet each week and becoming quite skilful by the end of the month. This is the second year that the Croquet Club has held a social tournament in March and it has encouraged several more people to consider ongoing membership.

On the last day of the event participants requested that we have a re-enactment of the Alice in Wonderland croquet match where the Queen of Hearts used flamingos for mallets. We had a selection of Mad Hatters, white rabbits, a Cheshire cat as well as some playing cards appearing on the day.



SOUTH AUSTRALIAN MEN'S GOLF CROQUET CHAMPIONSHIP

This event was held at Hutt Road in perfect weather conditions Friday 27th – Sunday 29th April. Brighton Croquet Club managed the event and Shirlene Mc Bride, Anne Woodhouse, Karen Magee and Graeme Thomas worked as referees. There were also many spectators supporting the men from a number of clubs, making the championship a vibrant place to be.

Day 1 (Friday) was Block play with 6 men in Block A and 5 in Block B.

In Block A after 3 matches (best of 3 games) with a time limit of 1 hour, 4 players were sitting on 2 match wins, with only net games and hoops separating them. Mick Reidy (Hyde Park) was leading this Block at the end of the day and Jim Grindrod (Aldinga Bay) was in second place.

In Block B at the end of this first day of play 2 players were also equal on match wins, but with only 5 players in the Block byes

were involved, therefore overall match wins were not a true indication of placings. Ronald McBride was leading the Block with 2 match wins and only 2 matches played, 3 other players were vying for second place in this early stage of the competition.

Day 2 (Saturday) Mick Reidy continued to display superb skills to win 4 matches and thus Block A. Second place was tight between Jim Grindrod, Heath Jackson (Hyde Park) and Greg Rowberry (Norwood), all on 3 match wins. Jim eventually won out with 4 net games to move to the semi-finals with Mick. Block B also had a clear winner; Ron was undefeated on 4 match wins, but again second place was less obvious at first sight. Barry Jennings (Hyde Park) wound up second over Eric

Day 3 (Sunday): Given this was a selection event for the State Team all players were again on the lawns to determine their final placings. All men were still playing matches (best of 3 games) with a time limit of one hour. The play was outstanding, jump shots through hoops from the boundary, clearances from the other side of the court and precision placement of balls to hamper opponents.
