**WCF** delays 2020-2023 events by one year

**RESTRICTED CONDITIONS OF PLAY AT HUTT ROAD**

- No one should enter the venue who has any cold/respiratory symptoms, who has had or been in contact with anyone with Covid 19 in the past 14 days.
- All attendees must complete the attendance sheet
- No spitting anywhere in venue
- Spectators are permitted in line with the Covid Safe Plan (20 inside, 80 outside).
- **The clubhouse** can be used WITH RESTRICTIONS. **Max. 20 inside** keep 1.5m apart  
 One person at a time should sign in, sanitise and put their bags down.  
 Players may leave bags/personal belongings inside.  
**No use of any Hutt Road cups/spoons/crockery.** Players must bring their own cup/spoon for coffee/tea. A limited supply of disposable cups may be available for 50c but please try to bring your own. **Event Manager to take lids off containers at start of event and replace at the end please and dispose of any used cups/stirrers.** Players may bring their lunch and eat it at the table (1 person at each end of table) and bring any cutlery or crockery required. Any meal purchased (including alcoholic drink) must be consumed seated at tables. No sharing of food. No standing at the bar. Snacks purchased (cans of drink/chips) can be consumed outdoors but must not be shared. No use of urns, kettles, or other shared drink containers.
- **Outdoor Chairs** - bench seats - one person seated at each end of the seat, other outdoor chairs may be used spaced 1.5 metres apart
- **Lawns** Players must always maintain a distance of 1.5 metres with one person per 4 sqm. Refer to Covid Safe Plan for venue limit (80 outside).
- **Hand Sanitiser or stringent hand washing** must be done by all players prior to and after play. In addition players may use disposable gloves provided and discard after play.
- **Equipment - One person per lawn** should set up and one person pack down lawns. Disinfectant spray must be used on all equipment used **except balls** including trolleys, hammers, door knobs. Spray pump sanitiser and hand sanitiser is in the shed and dries on contact. If balls are touched they can be washed inside (instructions inside). Alternatively use gloves for all equipment including balls and discard after use.
- Timers, clips and lawn dividers are not to be used without gloves or sanitation before and after use. Flags for AC - use an additional white peg instead of a corner flag to show where the corner spot is if necessary.
- **Balls** should be handled as little as possible. Players could use their feet for ball placement in AC or any player may wear disposable gloves.
- Players must leave the venue immediately after play/meeting signing out and cleaning hands
