

After being rescheduled as a result of hot weather, the Presidents' Trophy competition was played in milder, sometimes windy weather. The doubles competition was removed to expedite play over three afternoon/evening sessions. 15 players contested the event in a very competitive spirit. A number of players making their debut at this level were buoyed by notching wins against lower handicap players.

The competition was alive to the last round with Barry Haydon not necessarily safe, had Ron McBride pulled off a big win. Barry's consistency won out giving him 13 wins to Ron's 11. Just behind Ron on hoops was Kate Logan. Apart from Barry, Kate beat the 5 other players ranked higher than her in the competition, a great effort. The very high standard of play during the competition will have been gratifying to Ron McBride as he goes about developing the state team for 2018.

During a school visit in late 2016 a then 13yo lad by the name of Bill Hollier was introduced to 'Aussie' Croquet – and liked what he saw and played. So much so that he began to appear at the club on Wednesday afternoons, cycling down to the courts immediately after school. He also began to be a regular on Saturdays and it became obvious to many that he had a flair for the game especially as he quickly transitioned to Association. His keenness continued through 2017 during the latter part of which he began official games to assess his handicap level. Notwithstanding his skill he was not in a position to acquire his own mallet, so the offer of one from this notable player was immediately applied for – and gratefully accepted. Already, after only a few weeks, Bill has shown marked improvement and will, school permission dependent, appear in his first tournament in May.
