UPDATE ON COVID 19 ADVICE TO MEMBERS - ISSUED 4 MAY 2020

Thank you for your patience and engagement with Croquet SA as we move through these difficult times. We are incredibly grateful to our members for adhering to the rigorous restrictions put in place to protect us all and others from this virus. Croquet SA recognises the important contribution that croquet makes to active and healthy lifestyles as well as positive mental health for South Australians.

Croquet SA has been in daily contact with SAPOL and Office for Recreation and Sport during this time to proactively collaborate with them for a return to the sport. We are mindful of the challenges that our member demographic brings. As a result of our discussions, we advise that the previous restrictions on all croquet activity at clubs has been modified to allow restricted participation.

The Board reminds committees that each club is independently responsible for any gathering that may take place at their venue and as such may now determine whether to allow the lawns at the club to be used again for the purpose of practice. **The Clubrooms must still remain closed.** Any club agreeing to permit such gatherings is responsible for ensuring compliance with all Federal and State Government regulations in place, <u>https://www.covid-19.sa.gov.au/restrictions-and-responsibilities/events,-activities-and-gatherings</u>

Clubs should be aware that police are patrolling areas and that penalties for both clubs and individual members could apply for non-compliance.

Hutt Rd will remain closed for the time being and members will be updated about this in due course.

GOOGLEGROUPS MAILING LIST-GET ON IT


