PROMOTION & DEVELOPMENT

I've been considering how and what we learn from events, promotions, come and try's. Lists of contacts were offered to many city clubs as a result of the free competition at the RCC and Hammer time; people who'd entered our free competition but hadn't won. After discussion about how to go about approaching people clubs tried very hard to motivate these individuals but had little success. However, some new members have been gained at at least one city and one regional club from this exercise. Can we learn from our approach? I believe we can;

- 1. Realise that getting a positive response from a cold call is very difficult. Think about what were they offered & did it relate to the previous event they went to? The offer of "croquet lessons" is very different to going to a social event and is likely to be rejected unless that person has developed a very strong affiliation with croquet in a short time.
- 2. Use this list of people in your local area who have experienced croquet and enjoyed it enough to enter a competition, to advertise a social croquet event. Just email them your flyer!

My point is that we can learn from each situation and use that information when we plan the next event.

The other important process that needs to be completed when running any sort of event is feedback or evaluation. How can you evaluate anything when you haven't asked the participants for their subjective response to the event?

We provide a feedback form under the Hammer Time program and found it very useful. It's all about learning from experience.



Have you heard about "Play By the Rules" website?
