The tactics and strategies used by our top ranked players in these scenarios was skilful and entertaining - we don't often see this type of game at our local Clubs and more Association players should be encouraged to come and watch events with such high standard of play. When the result of a game is determined by the player who may be well behind, but plays a smarter tactical game, it is exciting to watch and a great way to learn.

Players in this event were Dwayne McCormick, Harley Watts, Mark Kobelt, Roger Buddle, Mark Senior, Murray Baum, Greg Rowberry and Ron McBride. The women were Mary Marsland and Shirlene McBride. Mary and Shirlene both had two good wins and the support between the players displayed great sportsmanship and respect. Mark Kobelt made the effort to drive on his own from Cleve (some 6 hours each way) to participate in this event. Dwayne and Harley both won 7 of their 9 matches with Dwayne the winner with a higher net hoop score (108)

Harley (84). Congratulations to Dwayne who has now had back to back wins in this Harley Watts & Dwayne McCormick event (he also won it in 2013). Mark Senior also had a good tournament and finished





third with 6 wins.


#### ALFRED JAMES HYDE PARK AC INVITATIONAL

In July 2019 the Hyde Park Croquet Club held its first Alfred James AC Invitational Event, generously sponsored by Alfred James Unley and the Unley Council. This three day event attracted 16 elite AC croquet players Australia-wide. Spectators from both country and local croquet clubs were not disappointed with the high and exacting level of play demonstrated during the event.

There was praise and awe as the crowd witnessed various starts of the game, break making, triple peels, stunning cross wiring and pegging out. With the completion of the opening four blocks, the Semi-finals and Plate matches followed on the second day.

As with all competitions, the finals were a spectacular event. With the best of three games, Simon Hockey (Crystal Brook) ranked 6th in the world and Hockey—winner Edward Wilson (Millswood) ranked 13th in the world contested it over several hours. Victory went to Simon Hockey (2 games to 1) as winner of the Gold Medal and

Perpetual Trophy with Edward Wilson runner-up for the Silver Medal. Both played superb, flawless games.
