# ASSOCIATION CROQUET—NORTHERN YORKE PENINSULA 2020/2021

The NYP Pennant 2020/2021 season commenced on 2 September after the cancellation of the 2019/20 season on 11 March.

The AGM was held in August and involved the reigning premier and runner-up teams being presented with their SACA flag and NYPCA cups.

Winners were Snowtown White with 36 match points, runner up Snowtown Blue with 24 match points. Other team results were Snowtown Gold 22, Wallaroo Blue 22, Wallaroo White and Moonta Green both 11.

6 teams will be competing for the 2020/2021 season—Snowtown Blue and White, Wallaroo Blue and White, Moonta Navy and Moonta Red. The programme will be five rounds with Christmas/summer break.

Plans are under way for the Master Games 2021 to be held in the District Council of Copper Coast from 15-18 April with games of Association Croquet Doubles and Singles and Golf Croquet. Matches will be played at Moonta and Kadina. Although entries do not open until November many interested players have made contact.

The invited women were Robyn Short, Barbara Hooper, Shirlene Mc Bride, Marga Podnieks, Shirley Howlett and Tracey Sincock.

There were a number of interesting matches with close results - Harley was forced to use a "Get out of Gaol" card to win his match against Roger - Roger was in top form and looked to be in a winning position at 22-1. Harley steadily worked his way back into the match to finally claim a 26-25 victory. Dwayne played brilliantly all weekend winning all his matches 3 with triple peels - his last opponent was Harley, and Dwayne once again played a faultless match to take home the President's Trophy for the third



successive year.
