Occasionally I still get asked what does our registration money get spent on and what does SACA do. We need to go back a few steps.

- The Croquet SA constitution states that clubs are the members of SACA.
- You as a player are a member of a club and your committee represents the club.
- Every month, except January, the board meets. Each director writes a report, including the treasurer; these are attached to the minutes and sent to all the clubs.
- Your committee should have a standing item on their agenda regarding the SACA minutes and reports. This gives the committees, your representatives to Croquet SA, the opportunity to be kept up to date with the issues and inform players as they see fit.

It's part of good governance for hard copies of the minutes to be available for players to peruse, likewise your club minutes So the next time you are wondering what's going on or where's the money going ask one of your committee member or read the hard copy.

The answers should be readily available.

The document has been sent to Artlab SA for an assessment of its condition and cost for restoration. The quote from Artlab for restoration of this important document is \$1,740.
