ACA GC BRONZE MEDAL SA DIVISION

A late withdrawal reduced the field for the ACA GC Bronze Medal 2019, SA Division, from 7 to 6 entrants. This meant the tournament which had been scheduled to be played from Friday 14th to Sunday 16th June could now be condensed into a two day event to be completed on Saturday 15th June.



Rain fell steadily while lawns were being set up on day one and the skies looked ominous but soon we saw good conditions for croquet - still and clear - and we even enjoyed bouts of sunshine for a while before the heavens opened again during the final Friday games.

Players completed three matches (each of three untimed games) on day one, and there was a clear leader at close of play but by the commencement of the second match on day two the state of play was much tighter. Jim, Grindrod and Ron McBride played each other in fine conditions in the final match to determine final rankings and the tournament was there to be won or lost by either of them in a thrilling finish.

In the end, victory went to Jim Grindrod with five matches from Ron McBride's 3 matches, with both players producing excellent shots under great pressure. Referees for the tournament including Anne Woodhouse, Caroline Fraser and Graeme Thomas. Millswood was the Venue Manager for the tournament.



INFORMATION from Chris Bolvig, Snowtown CC regarding changes to our obligations under the Incorporations Act

I know that there has been a change to section 56(5) of the Association Incorporation Act 1985 regarding Public Officers, so you will need to address this as a matter of urgency. The section now reads "An incorporated association must within one month after any change in the identity or address of its public officer give notice to the Commission containing prescribed particulars of the change."
There is an amnesty currently in place until 30 June 2019 on ensuring that this information is reported to Consumer

and Business Service. Failure to do so can incur a \$1250 fine.

You just need to advise them by letter including the name of your organisation to Consumer & Business Services GPO Box 1719 Adelaide SA 5001

COMPETITION ENTRY FEES—REMINDER

Clubs are now sent an invoice for entries and lawn fees. Clubs are requested to submit entries via the appropriate on-line entry form. For individual and doubles events players are also requested to complete an on-line entry and are encouraged to submit entry fees direct to Croquet SA via bank transfer.
