Golf Croquet Championships 2022

After months of planning the Golf Croquet National Championships arrived and so did the rain and more rain.

The first event (7th -9th September) was the ACA Gold and Silver Medals, contested by all the ACA Bronze Medallists from around the country. The competitors were Barry Haydon (SA), Greg Bury (Qld), Brett McHardy (WA), Jamie Gumbrell (NSW), Stephen Forster (Vic) and Phil Roach (Tas). This event was a round robin of best of 3 matches, played over 3 days. At the end of the round robin two players were tied on 4 matches each. Brett McHardy and Barry Haydon then had to fight it out to decide the Gold and Silver Medallist. In the end Brett McHardy won the Gold, leaving our own Barry Haydon to receive the Silver. Congratulations to both players. The medals were presented by Jim Clements, secretary of ACA just prior to the BBQ which was held on Friday 9th September.

From 10th to 13th September the Open Men's and Women's Singles were played at SACA and seven other near city venues. As these events had not been held since 2019, due to Covid-19, entries were at an all time high, with 48 men and 51 women participating.

The men's blocks were played at Hyde Park, Brighton, Millswood and North Adelaide, while the women's blocks were contested at SACA/South Tce, Norwood and Glenunga. After two days the sixteen players going into both knockout events were decided. The remaining competitors were offered the chance to play in the Plate competition along with several "plate only" entrants.

Teams from all states battled it out for supremacy over the next 5 days. At the start of the final day of competition three teams were in contention to win the coveted shield. NSW were eventual winners on a count back from WA, with SA finishing in third place. Presentations took place at the event dinner held at Rydges Skyline Restaurant.

- 1933 contributed to Melbourne Centenary celebrations and the establishment of MacRobertson Girls High
- 1934 co-founded an airline and sponsored London to Melbourne air race
