ACA's National Championships have finished with South Australian players doing very well. Barry Haydon achieved a first for South Australia by winning the Silver Medal in the Gold and Silver Medal competition. Well done, Barry.

Barry Jennings won through to the third round of the top 16 play-offs. Other SA players to make the top 16 play-offs were Paul Ensor, Ansi Baumanis and Mark Senior.

The results for the National Championships are:

Silver Medal – Barry Haydon
Men's Singles – Gary Phipps (WA)
Women's Singles – Jamie Gumbrell (NSW)
Interstate Shield – Western Australia from New South Wales.

All our Referee's performed very well in trying conditions. The weather was windy and generally wet. A big thank you to John Arney and Anne Woodhouse for organising and training a new generation of referees.

A debrief meeting for the ISS committee is scheduled for early October 2022 to find out what went well and what we can do better next time.

From me as the GC Director I would like to thank all the volunteers that put in a very gallant effort in making these championships a great success. A thank you get together (BBQ) is being planned shortly for the volunteers.

It is with sad news that I report that Graeme Thomas has decided to resign from the positions of State Team Manager and the Chair of the Selection Committee for personal reasons.

A meeting with Barry Haydon has been scheduled shortly to discuss Graeme's resignation, the GC and AC Coaching vacancies.

After witnessing the Western Australia Team awarding one of their team players an award for the Best Player of the Championships; I approached some members of the South Australian Team with the idea of doing something similar.

The consensus was that it is a good idea to give the State Team players an incentive to play at their best during the championships. I have offered to provide a bowl with a plaque for the best player to keep for themselves and request that the Board approve the purchase of a perpetual trophy to be displayed conspicuously at Hutt Road.
