2024 GC Bronze Medal Tournament

The Bronze Medal Tournament for 9+ players was scheduled to be played over three days from Saturday 10 February to Monday 12 February 2024. The event was managed by the North Adelaide Croquet Club and consisted of players from the Millswood, North Adelaide, Brighton, Aldinga Bay, Tea Tree Gully and Coromandel Valley Clubs.

The warm weather conditions became challenging with very hot weather forecast for the three days. The SACA Weather Policy came into force in order to maintain the health and safety of all persons present during the event. This action meant that Monday's play was cancelled and the event reduced to one and half days on Saturday and Sunday with only a single round robin of play.

Following a very challenging days play on Saturday, the players completed the final 2 rounds on Sunday morning before the 11:00 am cut off time with Ibrahim Farran (Millswood) as the overall winner and Gayle Searle (North Adelaide) as the runner-up. Well done to all players in such extreme conditions.

Introducing Ibrahim Farran

A player from Millswood Croquet Club Ibrahim believes he is the only Palestinian born person who plays Croquet in Australia.

Ibrahim started playing Association Croquet and for the last 3 years has added Golf Croquet. He recently won the SA Bronze medal for GC and believes he is the only person to win both AC and GC bronze medals in the same year.

Ibrahim takes pleasure in both codes of croquet because he enjoys the physical activity as well as making social connections.

Ibrahim grew up in a Palestinian refugee camp in Beirut (Lebanon) and then went to Germany on a scholarship provided by the United Nations. He qualified in Germany as a Trade Teacher in Carpentry completing his training in a German college. By chance he approached the Australian embassy and was offered the opportunity to come to Australia in 1970. Because Ibrahim is multilingual, he was asked by the pilot during that flight to Australia, to sup-



port the flight staff to interview passengers so that they could complete their customs paperwork. Ibrahim stayed for 3 years in Sydney, where he also met his Irish wife Ann. They moved to Adelaide for job opportunities and affordable housing in 1973. Ibrahim worked in Australia as a building contractor for 26 years. During that time, he studied part time to gain a degree from Flinders University and to work in finance.

Ibrahim played Football (Soccer) in Lebanon and Germany and was also an official referee for 5 years in SA. A promotional flyer from Millswood Croquet Club was placed in his letterbox to come and try Croquet. With no knowledge of croquet, Ibrahim decided to give it a try out of curiosity.

Ibrahim used to be a political junkie and very active politically. Now he spends his time with his current interests: sport and reading.

Singles play will be held during the day and evenings, with each player having up to 7 singles games over the 4 days, Thursday to Sunday.

There will be 4 seeded blocks in both doubles and singles. Cut off handicaps for blocks will be determined after final entries received.

Block winners will be determined by games won, then if level, net hoops.

Games will be 2 1/2 hours with turn after the bell for all blocks Handicap cards to be used.

Entry fee is \$20 each player for doubles and \$40 for singles. Cash Prizes will be awarded - \$40 each winner and \$20 each runner-up in doubles and \$80 each block winner and \$40 each block runner-up in singles
