The Glenunga Croquet Club is located at 8 Kingsley Avenue, Glenunga 5064, next to the Glenunga Tennis Club. It is two streets down from Aldi and the Dan Murphy's - Tony & Mark's Shopping Centre and less than 1km from the Burnside Shopping Village.

It is a recreational sporting membership club aimed primarily at providing the opportunity for residents of Burnside and surrounding suburbs to learn and engage in relaxing outdoor exercise and learn the sport of croquet. Croquet involves developing eye-hand coordination, flexibility, and mental skills, as well as social interaction. Complete ignorance of the game is no barrier to starting. The rules are simple. Some of us enjoy social croquet. Some of us enjoy competitive croquet especially as our skills develop. Coaching is available for potential members.

We welcome newcomers to come and try the game in an informal welcoming environment. The premises are owned by Burnside Council. The Council and the Club see the Club premises as a valuable community resource not only for playing croquet but for use by the community for other purposes when the croquet lawns are not scheduled for members games. Non-members, and community and business organisations may book the Club premises for private functions such as for birthday parties, yoga classes, discussion groups, bridge clubs, craft groups, end of year parties, etc.

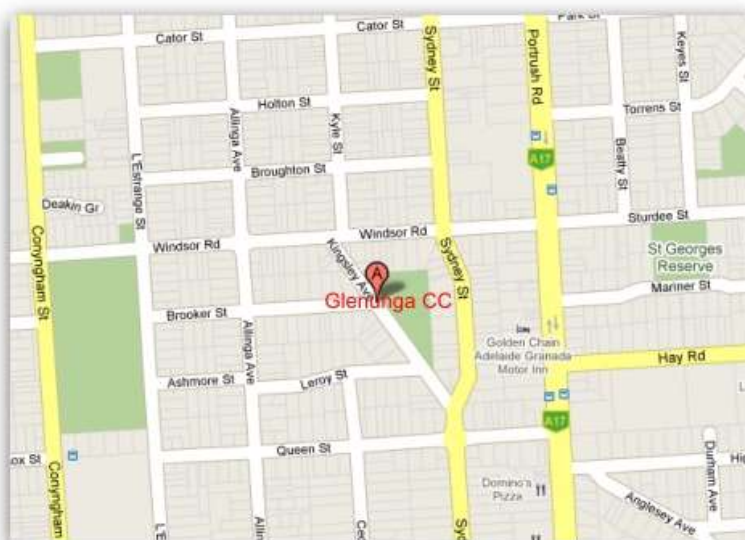
